Blochberger of Russellville, MO, is one of the CHA Region 9 Director and is located in Missouri. She has over 30 years of horse experience and has been teaching riding for more than 10 years. Blochberger became certified in 2006 and is currently a CHA Certified Instructor at Level 2 in English and Western. She owns and operates her own lesson and boarding business, B and B Farm, LLC. Blochberger is also an American Quarter Horse Association Professional Horseman, an American Paint Horse Association Professional Horseman, and an Open Horse Show Association Level 2 carded judge. Her volunteer work has included helping local saddle clubs and serving as a 4-H Horsemanship Leader and a

coach for FFA Horse Judging Teams. She is the past president of the Missouri Equine Council and has served on various other board positions within the horse industry.
